ISCAC Position Memo on Senate Bill S1373

Idaho hunters and anglers have always been generous to ranchers and farmers and have historically provided funds for compensation for damage by big game animals. Idaho's hunters and anglers will continue their generosity, and therefore, ISCAC will support S1373 to amend 36-110 to include grizzly bears in the program of compensation for depredation damage, using the same process currently used for black bears and mountain lions.

It is ISCAC's understanding that the projected increase to the Idaho Fish and Game depredation fund, Section 36-115(e), (Idaho Code) is estimated to be from \$1,000 to \$4,000 annually.
